# Perseverance in the Call of God

Lately the Lord has been saying "stay the course"

- don't shift or move away from what I am leading because of what is going on around you.
- It's easy to change course, step back, get discouraged
  - To do something different when we encounter resistance
- The Bible addresses this tendency with the word perseverance.
  - Perseverance means "Doing what God has led you to do until He leads you to do something else."
    - o It's one of the hardest disciplines that we face
    - The world around us has so many other

Do you know what God has called you to do?

- Are you getting itchy in that calling
- Do you see other things that are more attractive

# This week I felt like the Lord told me..

"Play for the coach, not the grandstands" – (Persevere in the Call of God)

- If you play for the coach, then you will stay in the game
  - If you play for the grandstands you will be sidelined
- If you play for the coach, you will win
  - If you play for the grandstands, you will lose
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  - There are amazing rewards for perseverance in the calling of God!
    - Gal 6:9 (NIV) Let us not become weary in doing good, for at the proper time we will reap a harvest if we do not give up.
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- Perseverance in the Call of God makes us mature
  - Jas 1:2-4 (NIV) Consider it pure joy, my brothers and sisters, whenever you face trials of many kinds, [3] because you know that the testing of your faith produces perseverance. [4] Let perseverance finish its work so that you may be mature and complete, not lacking anything.
- <u>Perseverance produces CHARACTER and HOPE</u>
  - Rom 5:3-5 (NIV) Not only so, but we also glory in our sufferings, because we know that suffering produces perseverance; [4] perseverance, character; and character, hope. [5] And hope does not put us to shame, because God's love has been poured out into our hearts through the Holy Spirit, who has been given to us.
- Testing the Vision Everyone in scripture who is called was tested
  - Heb 10:35-39 (NIV) So do not throw away your confidence; it will be richly rewarded. [36] <u>You</u> need to persevere so that when you have done the will of God, you will receive what he has promised. [37] For, "In just a little while, he who is coming will come and will not delay." [38] And, "But my righteous one will live by faith. And I take no pleasure in the one who shrinks back." [39] But we do not belong to those who shrink back and are destroyed, but to those who have faith and are saved.
    - "Death of a vision" Sometimes it happens 2X Sometimes 3X!
      - Death of vision means that EVERYTHING that God has promised seems to be lost
        - There is no way that the promises of God can come true
      - EVERYONE in the Bible was TESTED in the calling of God!
        - Abraham God promised a son when He was 75yo
          - <u>No son for 25 years</u>

- Sarah was past childbearing when the promise came
- ANOTHER 25 YEARS BEYOND THAT OLD!
- Moses God Promised to deliver Israel ..
  - Pharoah refuses to let people go "Make bricks without straw"
  - Moses is rejected and almost stoned by the elders
  - Then people suffered 10 plagues before deliverance
    - The Jews also suffered the first 3
- David Was Anointed King God led Samuel to make David King
  - Went back to tending sheep
  - Killed Goliath served the King for 7 years
  - Fell out of favor with King Saul
    - Saul hunted David for 7 Years
- Jesus was perfect,
  - o yet the religious leaders hated him
    - Called him names, accused Him
    - Tried to stone him
  - Was brought up on false charges and crucified on a cross
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- What happens when your calling in tested?
- Every calling from God must be tested!

# How does the Enemy attempt to keep us from persevering in the vision? THREE WAYS

- $\circ$  Distraction
- Discouragement
- o Isolation
- So many believers are sidelined
  - **Some are wounded** <u>They are double-minded</u>, unsure of God's calling and purposes
  - Many are casualties Their love is cold, they are ineffective in their calling

#### HOW DOES THIS HAPPEN? - Three ways.. Distraction, Discouragement and Isolation

#### Distraction

- Mat 6:31-34 (NIV) So do not worry, saying, <u>'What shall we eat?' or 'What shall we</u> <u>drink?' or 'What shall we wear?' [32]</u> For the pagans run after all these things, and your heavenly Father knows that you need them. [33] But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well. [34] Therefore do not worry about tomorrow, for tomorrow will worry about itself. Each day has enough trouble of its own.
- The enemy distracts you to keep you from encountering God
  - Your head is "humming" and cannot see or feel God
  - You are pinned down by worrying and being consumed about daily cares
- You are "marinating" in the cares of the world
  - Instead of being "marinated" in the Kingdom and relationship with Jesus
- IF YOU SEEK GOD"S KINGDOM His reign, His purposes, His direction
- IF YOU SEEK HIS RIGHTEOUSNESS Right Relationship
  - THIS WILL SILENCE THE "HUM" OF DISTRACTION IN YOUR HEAD
  - You will get clarity on what to do in every situation
  - SEEK HIS KINGDOM (His Leading)

- SEEK HIS RIGHTEOUSNESS (Right relationship with Him)
  - ALL OF THE OTHERS THINGS WILL COME INTO CLARITY
  - STOP THE MOMENTUM OF THE WORLD AND GET CONNECTED TO GOD
    - You
- $\circ$   $\;$  THE FLOW OF DIGITAL INPUT We are living in an age of distraction
  - When I was in college We lived lives that included Mandatory Reflection
    - No constant input from digital sources Podcasts, facebook, Instagram
      - No constant pressure to respond emails, texts, calls
        - NOW THERE IS NO MANDITORY REFLECTION
          - You can always DISTRACT YOURSELF with more/different input
  - We are **<u>flooded</u>** with information (texts, emails, newsfeeds, podcasts, social media)
    - 6-10 hours average (people spend on their devices- 2018)
  - I am convinced that many believers "SEEK FIRST THE MEDIA" instead of THE KINGDOM
    - These pursuits seem empowering but I notice a different fruit
      - FOMO produce the feeling that "I need to have/do more"
      - DISTRACTION I am not able to REFLECT on what God is doing/saying
        - Being alone with Jesus leaves us with peace and direction

# DISCOURGEMENT

- John 16:33 (NIV) "I have told you these things, so that in me you may have peace. In this world you will have trouble. But take heart! I have overcome the world."
- WE ARE ENCOURAGED WHEN WE HEAR AND AGREE WITH GOD
- WE ARE DISCOURAGED WHEN WE HEAR AND AGREE WITH THE ENEMY
- YOU PARTNER WITH GOD
  - When you believe what God says
  - The Message of God is WHO YOU ARE, YOUR GOD GIVEN PURPOSES and CALLING
- $\circ$   $\;$  YOU PARTNER WITH THE DEVIL
  - When you believe what the Devil says
  - The Message of the Enemy is about YOUR WEAKNESSES, YOUR INABILITIES
    - It's all about WHAT YOU CAN"T DO,
    - It's all about YOUR PAST FAILURES
- You have a choice of partnering with God or the DEVIL
  - PARTNERSHIP WITH THE DEVIL
    - BY AGREEMENT WITH NEGATIVE THOUGHTS THEY ARE NOT YOURS!
    - THEY SEEM REASONABLE
      - You are not strong enough
      - This is beneath you
      - Are you sure about this
    - The enemy reminds us of sin
      - Look at your hypocrisy
      - You are not loved by God because you keep sinning
      - If people really knew what was inside of you
- PARTNERSHIP WITH GOD
- 2 Cor 10:3-5 (NIV) For though we live in the world, we do not wage war as the world does. [4] The weapons we fight with are not the weapons of the world. On the contrary, they have divine power to demolish strongholds. [5] <u>We demolish arguments and every pretension that</u> <u>sets itself up against the knowledge of God, and we take captive every thought to make it</u> <u>obedient to Christ.</u>
  - We must RECOGNIZE the thoughts that ARE AGAINST THE KNOWLEDGE OF GOD
    - Thoughts that question what God says

- Thoughts that do not affirm Gods purposes for us
- We must TAKE CAPTIVE (recognize and replace) thoughts that the enemy delivers
  - MAKE THEM OBEDIENT to Jesus
  - We must bring them under the LORDSHIP OF JESUS
    - They are rendered powerless at the foot of the cross
    - $\circ$   $\;$  They are of no impact when brought into the presence of Jesus
  - We must understand and agree with What God Says about us
    - READ "STATEMENTS OF TRUTH" THIS IS WHAT GOD SAYS ABOUT US!

# Isolation

- Heb 10:23-25 (NIV) Let us hold unswervingly to the hope we profess, for he who promised is faithful. [24] And let us consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds, [25] not giving up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but encouraging one another-and all the more as you see the Day approaching.
- TWO-THIRDS (68%) of born again believers are not connected to a local body of believers
  - They are living "off the grid" socially
  - They are unattached... They have no support, accountability or face to face encouragment
  - Face to face connection with others is a necessary part of the new covenant
- You cannot engage in ANY OF ministry commandments without connection to the BODY
  - Staying away from BEING the Church is DESTROYING US!
  - It's like saying "being married is important" but your don't "live with" your spouse
    - You can "be married" when you are apart
    - AND you won't "stay married" when you are isolated
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  - WHAT HAPPENS WHEN YOU ARE GETTING READY TO BE WITH GOD'S PEOPLE
    - FOUR SCHEMES OF THE ENEMY TO KEEP US FROM TRUE FELLOWSHIP
      - I'm Tired "let's stay home and rest"
        - THE LIE: Physical rest will take the place of Spiritual connection/encouragment
          - Do you really "feel better" in isolation?
      - "I am not ok today" I want to be feeling better before I see people
        - THE LIE: I need to be feeling and looking Good to be with others believers
        - TRUTH: Being with others provides us with ministry / encounter with God
      - "I need to figure it out with God before I meet with people"
        - (Do you really get better in isolation?
      - "The situation in my life is outta whack" or "My kid is not having a good day"
        - THE LIE: Things need to be going ok in my life so that I show others how well I am doing
        - I don't want to look weak
        - I don't want anyone to think that I am not a good parent
      - "We will attend online today"
        - THE LIE: Watching church on a screen is the same as being in fellowship with other believers
        - Information can be transferred by watching TV
        - Fellowship must be done face to face.
- The Example of Jesus
  - Heb 12:1-2 (NIV) Therefore, since we are surrounded by such a great cloud of witnesses, <u>let us</u> <u>throw off everything that hinders</u> and the <u>sin that so easily entangles</u>. And let us <u>run with</u> <u>perseverance the race</u> marked out for us, [2] fixing our eyes on Jesus, the pioneer and

perfecter of faith. For the joy set before him he <u>endured the cross</u>, scorning its shame, and sat down at the right hand of the throne of God.

- Throw off the good things for the BEST things
- Get rid of sins (than tangle us up)
- RUN WITH PERSEVERENCE
  - BY... Fixing our eyes on Jesus (relationship, emulation)
- <u>Do not change course when things get hard</u>
  - 1Ti 4:16 (NIV) Watch your life and doctrine closely. Persevere in them, because if you do, you will save both yourself and your hearers.
    - Be guided by discernment, not feelings
